
✓ 3 "magic words" for Science, Technology and Innovation (STI) cooperation between Brazil (BR) and the European Union (EU)

# The Floor is all yours..



INCOBRA developed a support framework to encourage the creation of and/or foster sustainable STI partnerships between Brazilian and European networks.

Expected results:

- Joint submission of a proposal to any Europe Brazilian funded programme.
- Consolidation of a long term cooperation framework: signature of a MOU, partnership agreement or other kind of formal agreement
- Action Plan for coordination of R&I initiatives.
- Activity report with policy recommendations and description of needs and cooperation obstacles.



INCOBRA support to the selected bilateral networks starts on 15th April 2018 and will last till 15th November 2018.

A three-fold support package put in place by INCOBRA 1. The Grant Mechanism 2. The Mentoring Scheme 3. The Consultancy Services **Grant Agreement**

The **grant agreement** has to be signed by the legal representative of the network's coordinator and the legal representative of a partner of INCOBRA project on behalf of the whole consortium Reporting The **final activity report** has to be delivered to INCOBRA within 30 days from the end date of the

grant agreement (15th December 2018).

The grant of 19.500€ is disbursed in two tranches: I. 50% upon signature/entry into force of the grant agreement II. 50% upon delivery of the final report

#### **Grant Mechanism**

#### ELIGIBLE

- Organization of working meetings
- Travel expenses of networks' partners to networks' meeting and other relevant conferences and events (only economy class flights).
- Accommodation costs in max.
   4 star hotels
- ✓ Per diem allowance
- ✓ Consumables, printing costs

#### All costs must be

- actually incurred by the beneficiaries
- incurred during the action duration (during the grant period)
- incurred in connection with the network activities and necessary for its implementation
- identifiable and verifiable, properly recorded in the beneficiary's account
- in compliance with national laws
- reasonable, justified, complying with the principle of sound financial management and in line with the beneficiary's usual practices.



#### NON-ELIGIBLE

- X Staff costs for the implementation of the activities,
- X Physical resources, small equipment, etc.
- X Any type of honorarium or consultancy fee
- X Any research activity
- X Rental of venue

#### **Mentoring Scheme**

Definition of Bilateral Network's Action Plan and Communication Plan by 15<sup>th</sup> of April 2018:

- Objectives and expected outcomes of the network
- Description of work including
  - Network activities and timeline (Gannt Chart)
  - Communication and dissemination plan
  - Roles of partners involved (tasks division) Ο
  - Deliverables and milestones  $\cap$

**Monthly call with mentors.** Each network will be in contact with the mentors on a regular basis, at least once a month, and produce a brief report outlining the state of the art of the project, main achievements and progresses of the period, the challenges they are facing.

Ad hoc calls and emails whenever needed.

**Face-to-face meetings.** Mentors and co-mentors will attend the bilateral networks' meetings. Networks are requested to take minutes of all meetings (both in person and online).
