CO-ADVISORY AND DUAL DEGREE

The University of São Paulo can settle partnerships with foreign educational and research institutions for students' co-advisory aiming at preparing Doctorate and Master's thesis and dual degrees upon signing up an international academic agreement that associates USP to the foreign institution and implies reciprocity.

CO-ADVISORY

Through the INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC AGREEMENT FOR CO-ADVISING DOCTORATE AND MASTER'S THESIS, USP and foreign institution settle an agreement without specifying the name of the participant student. For each student applying for the co-advisory and dual degree, a term of commitment of accession to the agreement shall be settled. The agreement must be formalized before the effective beginning of the activities provided for in the agreement.

Requirements for foreign students:

- 1) The applicant must be regularly enrolled in a doctorate course of a foreign institution, should the defense take place abroad;
- 2) Signing up the agreement for co-advisory formalization with a view to dual degree (*link to minute*).

DUAL DEGREE

The University of São Paulo can settle partnerships with foreign educational and research institutions for students' co-advisory aiming at preparing the Doctorate thesis and Dual Degree upon signing up an international academic agreement that associates USP to the Foreign Educational Institution (IEE) and implies reciprocity.

The agreement must be formalized before the effective beginning of the activities provided for in the agreement. The applicant can be a doctorate or master's student enrolled at USP or IEE.

Requirements for students enrolled in IEE:

- Term of Commitment in duplicate (Portuguese and foreign language) that shall be signed only by the student and advisors after the agreement has been approved and signed;

- Work plan drawn up in foreign language to be developed at USP, stating the implementation schedule, aiming to meet the provisions for fulfilling at least a six-month period at USP;
- Copy of the diploma/certificate of undergraduate completion;
- Copy of the Master's diploma (if any);

Requests for support aids (tickets and trip) to defray the mobility of the Judging Commission of Thesis, including the advisors, within the Dual-Degree Agreement, must be forwarded to the PRPG and the Coordinating Research Committee to which the student or advisor is connected within 90 days in advance as from the date set for defense.
