OBSERVATION: The hour load for each subject of "Independent Studies" is divided throughout the course from the 1st semester, considering up to one credit per semester. Each student must take 10 elective subjects, 50% out of which (5 credits) shall be considered as "Independent Studies". Computer workshops and Database, which are offered to all students in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semesters, are considered "Independent Studies" as well as extension activities (courses of cultural diffusion, updating, and others); events (week of studies, conferences, seminars, round-tables, symposiums, meetings, journeys, lectures); scientific initiation; participation in study groups and research; director of academic center and any other type of student representation; student representation on statutory commission of Nursing School, central organs and others; monitoring; publications; foreign language courses.
