AI for Scientific Breakthrough: Applications and Innovations

Rules for "Roland Vencovsky" award

1. Abstracts

1.1. Only abstracts written in English will compete for the prize.

2. Evaluation Criteria

- 2.1. At each evaluation stage, the following criteria will be considered:
 - Innovation;
 - Scientific and/or Social Impact;
 - Applicability;
- 2.2. If no abstract meets the standard, the prize will not be awarded.

3. Process of evaluation

- 3.1. **Selection of the best abstracts**: The GVENCK members of the Event Scientific Committee will select the three best abstracts.
- 3.2. **Presentations**: The authors of the three best abstracts will each give a 10-minute presentation, followed by 5 minutes for questions, during an event session.
- 3.3. **Final Evaluation**: During this session, the guest members of the Event Scientific Committee will evaluate the presentations and rank them to determine the first, second, and third places for the "Roland Vencovsky" award.
- 3.4. **Note**: The presentation can be done in Portuguese.

4. Award Ceremony

- 4.1. The three best works will receive an honorable mention, and the first place will be the winner of the "Roland Vencovsky" prize;
- 4.2. The prize will be awarded at the closing ceremony of the event;
- 4.3. The authors of the three best abstracts will receive a free registration for the 9th IMPB in 2025.
