# Center for Higher Education Policy Studies (CHEPS)

#### http://www.utwente.nl/cheps

Policy-oriented research (basic + applied) and consultancy, and a bit of teaching (Public Admin/ European Studies)

#### Research themes:

- Governance, Quality, Management & Organisation, Funding of higher education
  - at the national/supranational/institutional/department levels

#### **Academic staff: 12 fte**

#### **Total Revenues: about 2 m€**

of which: 85% earned through market-oriented activities (research contracts & consultancies) for Ministries, Eur. Commission, research foundations, World Bank, universities, etc – from Europe and beyond (Africa, Asia, US, Australia)



## Rankings in higher education

- instruments to compare higher education institutions
- and to judge their relative position, usually in league tables
- based on the actual performance of these institutions
- Rise of global rankings (Sjanghai, Times Higher QS)
- New approach: U-Multirank





## Critique of existing rankings

- Aggregate performance into composite overall indicator
- Concentrate on 'traditional' research productivity and impact
- Focus on 'comprehensive research universities'
- Research data based on bibliometrics
  - Current databases imply cultural and language biases
  - bias against humanities and social sciences

# What is U-Map?

U-Map is an instrument that intends to show the diversity and enhance the transparency of the higher education landscape in the European Higher Education Area through the creation and publication of institutional activity profiles





# Classifications in Higher Education

- Instruments to group higher education institutions
- and to characterize similarities and differences
- Example: Carnegie Classification (since 1973)
  - 'Label' (e.g. regionally engaged teaching-oriented HEI)
- based on the actual conditions and activities of institutions





# Functions of U-Map

- A transparency tool for various stakeholders:
  - HEI's: instrument for institutional strategies (mission, profile)
  - Students: choices
  - Business and industry: partnership and relationships
  - Policy makers: base for governmental policies
  - Researchers and Analysts: tool for research
- Instrument for better ranking (e.g. U-Multirank)





# Challenges for universities

- Increasing expectations → risk of 'mission overload'
- Global research competition need for strategic research management
- Expansion of human capital formation 

   need to diversify educational provision

# Institutional profiles

#### **Crucial distinction:**

- Activity profiles : descriptions of actual activities
- Performance profiles: evaluative presentations of actual performances

#### **Profiles:**

- Can have various dimensions
- Should reflect the mission of the institution






# Institutional activity profiles

- Sets of scores on the dimensions and indicators
- Scores in four categories (none, some, substantial, major), or missing (no data available)
- Actual institutional <u>activities</u>, not performance
- Reference is the 'average' (EU) university in the sample
  - We have 350 in the data base = about 10-12% of all European higher education institutions



# Institutional activity profiles





### Institutional profiles: some remarks

- Flower, or sunburst chart
- Longer beams = more activity
- Does not express the quality or performance!
- Impossible to get all indicators 'maximum'
- A missing beam means: data not available
- No hierarchy in colours
   (e.g. red is not better than yellow)





### Institutional profiles: some remarks

- Is a snapshot picture, does not follow dynamics
- Needs to be interpreted within national context
- Set of standardised indicators permits benchmarking of local situation





### Institutional profiles: some uses

- Information for external stakeholders
- Instrument for strategic institutional management
- Basis for benchmarking, for inter-institutional cooperation, for effective communication Strategic profiling





## **U-Map status**

- 350 participating institutions
- Five national approaches
  - Netherlands (sponsored by Dutch MoES)
  - Portugal (sponsored by EU LLL program)
  - Estonia (sponsored by EU LLL program)
  - Flanders (sponsored by Flemish MoES)
  - Nordic countries: Denmark, Norway,
     Sweden, Finland, Iceland (sponsored by Nordic Council of Ministers)
- U-Multirank 1 & 2 (commissioned by EC)
- Open and password protected websites






# And now ... to USP!

## USP indicator scores

#### **Dimension: Teaching and Learning**

- 1. Doctorate degrees awarded: 17%
- 2. Master degrees awarded: 26.3%
- 3. Bachelor degrees awarded: 56.7%
- 4. Short first degrees awarded: 0%
- 5. Range of subjects:

Education: 2%; Humanities & Arts:

8,8%; Soc. Sciences, Law: 23,8%;

Science: 20,4%; Engineering: 14,7%;

Agriculture: 6,9%; Health: 21,7%;

Personal Services: 1,9%

- 6. Orientation of degree; general
  - formative: 14%
- 7. Licensed/regulated professions and other career oriented
  - Programs leading to licensed/ regulated professions: 67%
  - Other career oriented programs: 19%

#### **Dimension International Orientation**

- 17. Exchange students; incoming: 1.1%
- 18. Exchange students; sent out: 1.4%
- 19. Foreign degree seeking students: 1.3%
- 20. Non-national academic staff: 5.8%
- 21. International income sources: in lowest quartile





## **USP** indicator scores

#### **Dimension Research Involvement**

- 22. Peer reviewed academic publications per fte; 1,56
- 23. Professional publications: 0.27
- 24. Other research output: 0.12
- 25. Doctorate production: 0.41
- 26. Expenditure on research: 45%

#### **Dimension Regional Engagement**

- 27. Graduates in the region: more than 75%
- 28. New entrants from the region: 92%
- 29. Income from the region: 93%

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
## The new U-Map website

- Including/updating more profiles




