Dr. Francisco Quintana graduated at the University of Buenos Aires, obtained his PhD in immunology at the Weizmann Institute of Science and received postdoctoral training at the Weizmann Institute of Science and Harvard Medical School. Currently, Dr. Quintana is a Professor of Neurology at the Ann Romney Center for Neurologic Diseases, at Brigham and Women's Hospital, Harvard Medical School, an Associate Member at the Broad Institute of Harvard and MIT, and the President of the International Society of Neuro Immunology (ISNI). Dr. Quintana's research investigates signaling pathways that control the immune response and neurodegeneration, with the ultimate goal of identifying novel therapeutic targets and biomarkers for immune-mediated disorders.
