

Print PVE – Visiting Researcher from Abroad Scholarship – Calls 2024 – Information for foreign researchers

University of São Paulo – Print/CAPES Program

The Print Program is an initiative led by USP and the Brazilian Federal Agency CAPES (<http://www.capes.gov.br/>) to foster the building, implementation and consolidation of strategic plans for the internationalization of top Brazilian research institutions. It aims to stimulate the formation of international research networks with special interest to:

- a) Improve the quality of academic production linked to postgraduate studies;
- b) Expand the internationalization policies to support the postgraduate programs;
- c) Promote the mobility of academic staff and PhD students; and
- d) Stimulate the transformation of institutions into an international academic environment.

USP Print Program is divided in five thematic areas that will range from 2019 to 2024. The main areas are:

1. Arts and Humanities – AAH
2. Earth and Space – EAS
3. Health and Disease – HAD
4. Technology – TEC
5. Translational Plant and Animals Sciences – TPAS

The funds are applied in different lines, all of them bound to yearly public calls specific to the eligible USP postgraduate programs (found [here](#)), divided by thematic areas. For 2023 (July 2023 to December 2023), the opportunity for international visitors to come to the University of São Paulo is as follows:

Visiting Researcher from Abroad Scholarship

Details: Experienced international researchers hosted by USP Graduate Program during **7 to 15 days** for activities that promote international excellence within individual or joint graduate programs.

Eligibility: Visiting researchers must have a solid and outstanding scientific career. He/she shall have a formal connection with an international research institution and may not be currently living in Brazil. **Application is submitted by the interested graduate program at USP.**

Applications for visits are open until November 23, 2023. Interested parties should get in touch with their peers at the University of São Paulo for instructions on how to proceed.

Documents for applications:

- Work plan in English (maximum 10 pages), prepared in common agreement by the visiting professor candidate and the Postgraduate Program Coordination, containing: title, proposed activities, schedule and justification.
- curriculum vitae (maximum two pages) containing the 5 (five) most prominent publications (or other type of production)
- Link to the Google Scholar profile in the case of candidates from the humanities area and link to the Scopus profile for candidates from all other areas.
- Copy of the document proving the doctor's title or statement from your institution attesting to your doctor's status.
- Declaration from the USP Postgraduate Program coordination, expressing the acceptance of the visiting professor, specifically stating: the days of visit requested, the name of the visiting professor and the institution of origin of the visiting professor.
- Declaration in Portuguese or English, from the candidate for visiting professor, demonstrating agreement with his/her participation in the period of the visit, which must have a single and uninterrupted stay period of 07 (seven) to 15 (fifteen) days.
