Brazil, hybrid vehicles and CO₂



In Brazil by applying the correction factors: Slightly better fuel economy



- Running the car to show the fuel economy doesn't vary like the conventional car
- Brazil may adopt other kind of measurement for hybrids (3 cycles??)
- Database with over 2000 tests using same circuit (since 1994)
- ≈ 1 hour driving under regular conditions (24 to 28 km/h) no air conditioning, single driver, window closed
